Dear Parents/Caregivers

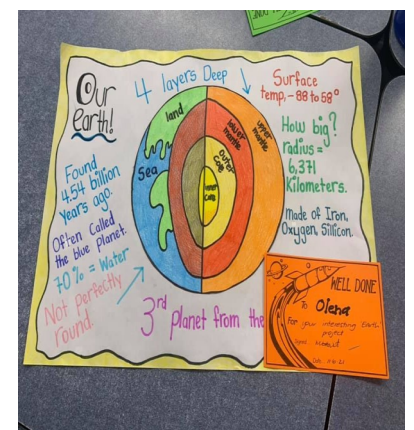

VISIT FROM OLYMPIC AMBASSADOR ROSE KEDDELL

Rose Keddell, an Olympic ambassador, and a great member of the Black Sticks hockey team visited our school to talk about her Olympic experience. Rose was born in Tauranga on the 31st of January 1994 and attended Bethlehem college. She started playing hockey at the age of five. Rose is a first cousin to Olympic sprinter Mark Keddell and Olympic gold medalist rower Mahe Drysdale. She competed in the 2010 summer youth Olympics as part of the New Zealand girls hockey team where she won a bronze medal.

She was selected for the Black Sticks women's team in November 2012, and played her first match against India in Napier on December 8th 2012. When Rose started playing hockey, she set herself goals. Her big goal was to be in the Black Sticks hockey team, that she would go to the Olympics and do the sport she loves.

Like at schools, there are Olympic values. They are respect, friendship and excellence. Rose showed all of these qualities when she was playing. Being respectful is when your team loses a game. Friendship is helping someone up from the opposite team and excellence is playing well and trying your best.

Rose Keddell is an inspiration to those who have dreams about becoming athletes in the Olympics. She has shown perseverance when times were hard, she was a good sport when her team lost a game even though she was disappointed. She also showed kindness to her teammates.
